BEATS	
1, 2, 3, 4 5, 6 7, 8	<p>VINE RIGHT, TOUCH, VINE LEFT, TOUCH.</p> <p>Step R to side, step L behind R, Step R to side, touch/tap left beside R Step L to side, step R behind L Step L to side, touch/tap right beside L</p>
1, 2, 3, 4 5, 6 7, 8	<p>VINE RIGHT, TOUCH, VINE LEFT, TURNING 1/4, TOUCH.</p> <p>Step R to side, step L behind R, Step R to side, touch/tap left beside R Step L to side, step R behind L (turning 90 deg left) Step L to side, touch/tap right beside L</p>
16	TOTAL BEATS
	<p>REPEAT DANCE</p> <p>* Note: This is a very old dance, said to have originated in the early days of linedance in the honky tonk bars of America.</p>
